Caution: Always make sure that firearm is completely unloaded before performing any work. These instructions provide gunsmiths and home builders with useful tips for installation. This is a relatively simple task but does require careful, patient work and a certain amount of mechanical skill. Please consider returning the kit for a refund or taking it to a gunsmith to install if you have any doubt as to whether you are capable of performing the installation.

Congratulations and thank you for purchasing this stock adapter for your Leader Arms AR12 shotgun. This product enhances your AR12 by giving you the means to install a common, AR15 style buffer tube assembly that will accept the collapsible buttstock of your choice.

Tools Needed

Phillips head screwdriver 8mm hex driver approx. 9in min long ratchet extension Ratchet wrench

Installation

First, remove the original buttstock from firearm. This is accomplished by sticking a Phillips head screwdriver through the circular mold marks in the existing rubber buttpad. There should be tiny holes in the rubber that allow your screwdriver to go through and access the buttpad screws. A little WD-40 or soapy water on the screwdriver will make it easier to turn.





Once the buttpad is removed, you can unscrew the long buttstock bolt with an 8mm nut driver on a medium length extension as shown.





Now you can install the buttstock adapter. Press the adapter into the buttstock pocket and use the supplied socket-head bolt to mount firmly to the gun.

*** Note: Some of these guns have "interference fit" mounting threads so that a standard M8 bolt will seem tighter than normal going in. Application of a small amount of lubricant may be necessary for ease of assembly.



With the adapter installed, you can screw in a standard (milspec or commercial) AR15 buffer tube, lock it in pace with a castle nut, and finish off with a collapsible buttstock of your choice.
